

What are cookies

Cookies are small files saved and stored on the user's desktop or portable computer while he visits various pages on the internet. A cookie usually contains the name of the website it comes from, "length lifetime "(that is, the time of its existence), and a randomly generated unique number used to identify the browser from which a connection to the website is made.

Cookie files policy

1. In connection with the provision of the content of the hotelmaggi.pl website, the so-called cookies, i.e. information saved by servers on the user's end device, which servers can read every time you connect to this end device, it may also use other technologies with functions similar or identical to cookies. In this document, information regarding cookies also apply to other similar technologies used as part of our websites. Cookies constitute IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the website user's end device online hotelmaggi.pl. Cookies usually contain the domain name of the website they come from, and storage time their on the end device and a unique number.

2. Cookies are used for the purpose of:

- 1) adjusting the content of the website pages to the user's preferences and optimizing the use of websites internet; in particular, these files allow to recognize the device of the website user and accordingly display a website tailored to his individual needs,
- 2) creating statistics that help to understand how website users use websites, which is possible improving their structure and content,
- 3) maintaining the website user's session (after logging in), thanks to which the user does not have to on every subpage re-enter your login and password on the website,
- 4) providing users with advertising content more tailored to their interest.

3. Within the hotelmaggi.pl website, we can use the following types of cookies:

- 1) "necessary" cookies, enabling the use of services available on the website, e.g. authentication cookies used for services that require authentication on the website,
- 2) cookies used to ensure security, e.g. used to detect fraud in the field of authentication in as part of the website,
- 3) cookies, enabling the collection of information on the use of the website pages,
- 4) "functional" cookies, enabling "remembering" the settings selected by the user and personalizing the interface the user, e.g. in terms of the language or region the user comes from, font size, page appearance website etc.,
- 5) "advertising" cookies, enabling the delivery of advertising content to users that is more relevant to them interests.

4. In many cases, web browsing software (web browser) allows it by default storing cookies on the user's end device. Website users can make changes at any time cookie settings. These settings can in particular be changed in such a way as to automatically block handling cookies in the web browser settings or informing about their every posting on the device website user. Detailed information on the possibilities and methods of handling cookies is available in the settings software (web browser). Failure to change the cookie settings means that they will be included in user's end device, and thus we will store and retrieve information on the user's end device access to this information.

5. Disabling the use of cookies may make it difficult to use some services on our websites, in especially requiring login. However, disabling the option of accepting cookies does not make it impossible to read or viewing the content posted on the hotelmaggi.pl website, subject to those to which access requires logging in.

6. Cookies may be placed on the end device of the user of the hotelmaggi.pl website, and then used by advertisers, research companies and suppliers of multimedia applications cooperating with the website.
