

## **GDPR information clause regarding data processing personal**

4. The categories of personal data include, inter alia, name and surname, telephone number, e-mail address, address, data dedicated to the process / service / project;
5. Your personal data may be transferred to entities processing the data personal data on behalf of the administrator: IT service providers;
6. Your personal data will be kept for the duration of its existence legally the legitimate interest of the administrator, unless you object to data processing;
7. Your data will not be transferred to a third country or organization international;
8. You have the right to access your data and the right to rectify it, deletion, processing restrictions, the right to transfer data, the right to submit objection, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting compliance with the right to process based on consent before its withdrawal;
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority dealing with security personal data, which is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, when they deem it you that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the Act of 10 May 2018 on the protection of personal data (consolidated text, Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000) or the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to data processing personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing the Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) of 27 April 2016. 10. The data provided by you will not be automated decision making and profiling;
11. The data comes from the data subjects; services provided by the company.
12. Providing your personal data is self-imposed.
